Australian High Commissioner to India Visits VidyaGyan Leadership Academy in Sitapur and Addresses the Students

Lucknow, April 20, 2017: The Australian High Commissioner to India, Ms. Harinder Sidhu visited the Sitapur campus of VidyaGyan, a leadership academy for meritorious and economically underprivileged students from rural Uttar Pradesh, today. An initiative of the Shiv Nadar Foundation, VidyaGyan was established in 2009 to select and nurture potential high achievers from rural Uttar Pradesh and provide them a platform to excel in whatever field they chose. Currently, there are close to 1900 students studying at the two campuses of VidyaGyan, located in Bulandshahr and Sitapur.

Her Excellency, Ms Harinder Sidhu addressed the students of VidyaGyan and also inaugurated the Greenhouse Center of Learning at the school's Sitapur campus. The newly established "Greenhouse Center of Learning" comprises three open and glass topped class-rooms and is a reflection of VidyaGyan's continued quest to provide the best-in-class infrastructure and an inspiring, innovative and creative learning environment to its students. Located in the seven-acre Mango Orchard, this Centre will offer a physical learning space that seamlessly integrates the formal set-up of classroom training with the openness of nature."

Ms. Harinder Sidhu, Australian High Commissioner to India** said, *"VidyaGyan is an interesting and radical model as it can address the problem of inadequate leadership for every developing nation.
